In accordance with the Privacy (Australian Government Agencies – Governance) APP Code 2017, NAIF publishes a Privacy Impact Assessment Register on the NAIF website on a bi-annual basis. The Privacy Impact Assessment Register lists Privacy Impact Assessments for all projects that:

- Involve a significant change to how we manage personal information; and
- Might have a significant impact on the privacy of individuals.

NAIF conducts Privacy Impact Assessments (PIAs) for projects with high privacy risks. Throughout the assessment process, we:

- Identify elements of the project that may impact an individual's privacy;
- Devise strategies to manage, reduce, or eliminate any potential impacts; and
- Publish the assessment outcomes on this page for transparency.
